## **LAUSD Board Member Nury Martinez To Host Parent Advocacy Day to Educate Parents about their Choices in the Upcoming Election**

***Board Member's Office Will Hold Workshops to Encourage San Fernando Valley Parents to Vote and to Provide Them with More Information about Propositions 30, 32 and 38***

**WHAT:** With less than two weeks until Election Day on November 6, LAUSD Board Member Nury Martinez is hosting "Parent Advocacy Day" to provide informational workshops to community members in the Northeast San Fernando Valley about their choices in the upcoming election. These workshops will encourage participants to vote and will also provide them with more information about Propositions 30, 32 and 38.

LAUSD Chief Financial Officer (CFO) Megan Reilly will present information regarding the financial challenges in funding public education and the ramifications of "trigger cuts" in Los Angeles if Proposition 30 does not pass. There will also be informational workshops available to participants concerning the critical importance of continuing to fund early education.

Parents will have the opportunity to ask the Board Member, the CFO and the representatives from the Propositions 30, 32, and 38 how their choices in the upcoming election will directly affect them and their family.
