**LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD), BOARD DISTRICT 1
SPECIAL RUNOFF ELECTION**

LOS ANGELES (July 8, 2014) — Interim City Clerk Holly Wolcott would like to remind voters of important dates pertaining to the Vote-By-Mail (VBM) process for the LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Runoff Election to be held on August 12, 2014.

First and Last Day to Apply for a VBM Ballot

Those who intend to vote in the LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Runoff Election may submit an application for a VBM ballot beginning Monday, July 14, 2014. All applications must be received by the Election Division **no later than Tuesday, August 5, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.** Applications can be mailed to the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division, 555 Ramirez St., Space 300, Los Angeles, CA 90012 or faxed to the Election Division’s VBM Section at (213) 978-0611 or (213) 978-0612. If you are a permanent VBM voter, you do not need to complete an application; you will receive a VBM ballot automatically.

Applications for a VBM ballot can be found on the back cover of the Official Sample Ballot, which is mailed to all registered voters. Applications are also available on the Election Division website in English and the following languages: Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, and Vietnamese.

In-Person Voting in Election Division Office

Voters may also receive a VBM ballot in person at either of two City Clerk locations. See below for locations, dates, and hours of operation.

California State law gives all registered voters the option to vote by mail regardless of whether or not they anticipate being “absent” on Election Day. A voter who is not currently a permanent VBM voter must submit an application in order to receive a VBM ballot for each election.
